Reason for the amendment

The eligibility criteria are laid down to ensure that candidates aspiring for a given ASU post fulfil these criteria to be deemed fit for such an office. The criterion pertaining a given candidate's experience in the council is unclear as to when exactly the candidate should fulfil this particular criterion. Since the office bearers assume charge at the valedictory of the annual conference, there is a ground for argument in the case of a candidate who has submitted the nomination but would complete the stipulated term of office during the valedictory, who at least by the letter of the bylaw becomes eligible for the post as such a candidate meets the eligibility criterion by that time.
