He has served as an honorary Prof of Urology at Madras Medical College with distinction till his superannuation. He was among the first of the batch of MCh Urology course of Madras University. He was a respected teacher and a great innovator.

He delivered the prestigious Pinnamaneni Oration of USI at Kanyakumari and was also the first orator of S.B. Umapathy oration of Tapasucon. On behalf of the South Zone and the Executive council we pay homage to the departed soul. Our heartfelt condolences to the bereaved family of Prof K.Ravishankar.

Dr V N Bhat Muliyala was born in Enmakaje village in Kasargod. He studied BSc at St Aloysious college Mangalore and MBBS at Calicut Medical college. He studied MS Gen. Surgery at Trivandrum Medical College and MCh Urology at PGI Chandigarh

He worked in Kerala Medical College service, GMC Alleppey, GMC Kottayam and retired as Prof of Urology from Government Medical College, Calicut. After retirement, he moved to Mangalore and worked as Urologist at Medical chambers and as Professor of Urology at K S Hegde Medical College. He also worked in the Cooperative Medical College (now GMC) Kochi, for a short period. His career was illustrious. He was a pioneer in endoscopic Urology work in India and was first person to do TURP in Travancore.
