Dear Friends,

Greetings to all of you for a wonderful 2013!

I thank you for giving me the opportunity to steward the working post of the Honorary Secretary. I am grateful to my immediate predecessors for having successfully overseen the ASU affairs in the previous period 2010 -12.



I must apologise for the late release of this edition, which partially arose from the fact - 2012 saw several State conferences getting pushed into the tail of the year and I wanted to include the reports to make this issue a comprehensive one. This issue of our Newsletter combines September and December.

Kudos!! to our members – we have created history, and snapped top 3 positions at the National level (USI) - **President - Dr R.M.Meyappan, Hon.Secy - Dr D.Ramesh and Treasurer - Dr R Keshavmurthy** I must also congratulate Drs H.Krishnamoorthy and Pitchai Balashanmugham elected as council members representing the zone.

In a small departure from the past the council decided to meet mid midterm at Chennai during the last week of September 2012 to coincide with the TAPASUCON which unfortunately changed date and place. This meeting served the purpose of a new council acquainting its members to each other and airing ideas to infuse some vigour into the zone. As we all know this is a heavy zone with close to 700 members and if we set our mind can produce useful material in all aspects of holistic medicine - research, practice standards, community outreach and education of self, other physicians and the community.

The last six months since the Annual meet in Hyderabad has been the business end with all State chapters having their conference. I managed to attend two of these – KUACON at Gulbarga and TAPASUCON at Coimbatore. These are two cities at different points in the metro-town spectrum. What was visible was the tremendous enthusiasm that consumed everybody despite the shortcomings of a smaller place. It is important to encourage smaller cities to host events, these provide avenues for people to see the place, experience the local culture, enhance the growth of departments and in the process encourage local talent and interest in the Speciality. However, in the process one must be careful not to lower standards in providing academic ambience and infrastructure. Thanks to technology we have the ability to provide excellent information dissemination systems at a reasonable cost, if one were to spend time and energy to obtain the same. Another cause of concern which is unfortunately growing fast is the constant disconnect between the Organising committee of an event and the respective Council be it the City, State or Zonal chapter. There are frequent misunderstandings and these culminate in ugly exchanges at GBMs and leave a bad aftertaste, however good a conference. In my opinion many such contradictions can be avoided by having written protocols for all elements of a conference and also maintaining a clear non-ambivalent communication between all team members. Of course when there are differences, it will be useful if Senior members can transfer some of their farsightedness and follow ‘whats good for the majority’ philosophy. The decision of the Council be it State or Zone level shall prevail in such matters.

Some interesting ideas have emerged at the two council meetings conducted thus far in Chennai and Pune. We will make all efforts to put these into action. Some of these changes will be evident at the next Annual conference in Mysuru. You can be very proud of the fact - we possess an excellent directory, a handy ready reference book and now a CD that offers a perspective into the camaraderie of this zone. Our financial position is quite comfortable, and we have just received a bounty - whopping **Rs.25 lakhs as proceeds from USICON 2012** conducted by the Bengaluru group.

This newsletter contains messages from the President, reports from the various state meetings, prizes and awards granted, minutes of the AGM at Hyderabad as well as annual calendar of events. 23rd ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF THE ASU SZ – USICON 2012 – 13-15th July,2012 – Marriott,Hyderabad

The 23rd Annual Conference of the Association of Southern Urologists-South Zone USI 2012, was held in Marriott Hotel and Convention Centre , Hyderabad on 13th ,14th & 15th of July, 2012. There was a pre conference CUE along with European Society of Paediatric Urology on 13th convened by Dr. N. Mallikarjuna Reddy. This was a well attended programme with good interaction between the delegates and guest faculty represented by Dr. Ramnath Subramanyam, UK and Dr. Jorgan Thorup, Copenhagen.

The symposium and interactive panel discussion on “Which laser in BPH”, convened by Prof. A. Mohan, Bangalore was well attended and the Faculty Drs. Anil Varshney, Mohan Kesava Murthy, Ramesh Ramaih and Dilip Dhanpal gave a balanced view of merits and demerits of various lasers.

The conference was well attended and Dr. Rajendra Nerli, Hon’ Sec, ASU brought out a wonderful scientific session. There were over 500 delegates, more than 100 accompanying persons and about 50 companies participated in the conference. The conference was inaugurated by Prof. I. V. Rao, Vice Chancellor, Dr. NTR Health University, Vijayawada and graced by USI council represented by Dr. Jagdish N Kulkarni, President, USI, Dr. S. K. Singh, Hon’ Sec.
