II Amrita International Workshop & CME on Uro-Oncology (Report by Dr.Ginil Kumar, Kochi).

The second Amrita International Workshop and CME Uro Oncology was conducted on April 18th and 19th at Amriteswari Auditorium in Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences by the Uro Oncology division of Dept of Urology, Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences, Kochi. Dr Appu Thomas was the organizing chairman, Dr Ginil Kumar, the organizing Secretary and Dr Kannan Nair, the joint Organizing Secretary. The faculty list included Dr Murugesan Manoharan from Miami University and eminent Uro-oncologists from India. The relevant and controversial topics in the current scenario related to Uro Oncology were discussed extensively. The cases demonstrated included Robotic Radical Prostatectomy, Robotic Partial Nephrectomy, Robotic Radical Cystectomy with complete intracorporeal diversion, Laparoscopic Partial Nephrectomy, Open Cystectomy and Neobladder, TRUS biopsy and NBI guided TURBT.





The main highlights of the conference were:

- 1. This was the first workshop conducted in India with the Da Vinci Xi robot.
- The CME and Workshop were conducted side by side with complete utilization of time so that the delegates couldgain maximum information about the theoretical and surgical aspect of Uro Oncology within the two days of the conference.
- The work shop was very comprehensive and gave an opportunity for the delegates who came from across the country to know the development that is happening in the field of Uro Oncology including the technological advances.
- 4. The case discussions on Prostate, Kidney and bladder were very interactive and useful. The case discussions showed the limit to which the patient care can be taken by multimodality approach and aggressive surgical approach.

Scientific Papers For Presentation During SZUSICON 2015

The scientific papers for presentation in various categories during SZUSICON 2015 were invited for submission through Microsoft CMT Program. ASU received a total of 166 papers. The papers were evaluated on-line by a panel of 6 reviewers, whose comments and marks were made available to the authors. After evaluation, 134 papers were accepted for presentation during the conference. The rejected papers included papers with very low marks (7), papers sent by non-members inspite of repeated appeal to become members (20), papers sent as duplication (3) and papers from authors who had more than two other presentations during the conference (2). The best six papers from Podium and Video categories were included in the respective prize sessions. 3 best papers from Ideas & Innovations were also included in that Prize session. The category/session to which other papers were allotted, guidelines for presenters, detailed scientific program etc are available in the website.

Dear colleagues,

It has been a hectic year for the Association of Southern Urologists, ever since I took over as the Hon. Secretary of the society for the second time. I consider myself lucky to have been bestowed with this rare honour, which I believe may be solely because I always keep the society close to my heart!

Academic Activities

The conduct of the Silver Jubilee Conference of ASU at Kochi on 8-10 August 2014 really gave a silver tag to our society and will be regarded as one of the best ever conferences organised in the country. The very motto of the conference, Go Green, Save Earth reflected in every aspect of the organisation of this milestone conference. The conference witnessed the participation of a record of over 900 delegates. The scientific program was worthy of attending to every participant. I hope this conference will linger in the memories of everyone for a long time to come. The senior members and past office bearers were also honoured during the occasion.

The 2nd ASU-Prof.H.S.Bhat Mid Term Workshop was again conducted at Kochi in the IMA House, very well organised befittingly by Dr.Sanjay Bhat. The topic Vesical Dysfunction – Womb to Tomb was discussed and simplified by stalwarts in the field. Nearly 90 delegates took part in this wonderful annual academic program of ASU, commemorating the death anniversary of the legendaryProf. HSB.

The annual conferences of the state chapters were successfully organised in various places. The 28th Annual Conference of UAK was held on 8 August 2014 prior to SZUSICON at Kochi, the 26th Annual Conference of the APSOGUS was held at Kakinada on 14-16 November 2014, 19th Annual Conference of KUA was held at Bangalore on 13-14 September 2014 and 19th Annual Conference of TAPASU was held on 27-28 September 2014 at Tuticorin. Each of these conferences was one better than the other one and witnessed heavy attendance. In addition, UAK organised an additional CME program named UROCLINICS on 19 October 2014 at Thiruvananthapuram, Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences, Kochi conducted the Amrita CME for postgraduate students in March 2015 and the second Amrita International CME & Workshop on Uro-Oncology on 18-19 April 2015. All these programs were also of high academic standards. In addition, members have been conducting various academic programs and medical camps on individual and institutional basis for the benefit of Urology community

The arrangements for 26th Annual Conference of ASU (SZUSICON 2015) are in full swing for conduct at Vizag on 10-12 July 2015. The Conference will again witness academic and extra-academic activities of superlative standards, including video conferencing from experts from national and international centres and a master class by Prof.Studor himself.

The scientific papers for presentation in various categories during SZUSICON 2015 were invited for submission through Microsoft CMT Program. ASU received a total of 166 papers. ASU also acknowledges the services of Dr.Meenakshy Krishnamoorthy who efficiently co-ordinated and maintained the Microsoft-CMT of SZUSICON 2015 As part of the academic activities, a draft South Indian consensus on management of a very common clinical problem, named GUTB was formulated and consolidated after getting the opinion of all the members. This was also available on the ASU Website and members were requested to make their suggestions during the Consensus Meeting during SZUSICON 2015 at Vizag.

ASU has also given research fellowships to two Associate Members for conducting research activities under the banner of ASU, the final reports of which will be submitted to the society by December 2015 and published in the Website thereafter.

Many of our members have been presenting scientific papers in regional, national and international conferences and have been bringing laurels to our society. The USI activities have also been creditable, with many of our own members being re-elected for the office. There has been quite a large number of scientific publications from our members in various journals.

Society Matters

The Association of Southern Urologists is proud to be the second professional body of Urologists in India to have a total membership strength of more than 1000 members, after USI. It is heartening to note that more and more new members are joining the society. This year, more than 80 new members joined ASU!

As part of streamlining the activities of ASU, the process of reregistration has been on. We could collect all the details of the activities of the society from 2002 onwards and submit to the Registrar of Societies for evaluation. We expect a positive reply and get all the activities/amendments re-registered soon.

The financial status of the society is very healthy and all the regulations of the IT are being conformed. However in order to undertake more academic programs in tune with the international standards, the society needs a healthy corpus. As desired by the members, all the sponsors of the named Awards/Fellowships/ Orations have been contacted repeatedly requesting for renewal of their contributions and many of them magnanimously consented to contribute more for continuation of their respective named programs during annual conferences. A few of them have expressed their inability to contribute more. Therefore it will soon be decided to archive the names of these senior members without whose whole hearted support, the society would not have reached its status as it is now. We also expect contributions from new members for institution of new academic activities in future.

With the division of Andhra into two states, it may be difficult to continue the present system of allotting registration numbers to the ASU members starting with the abbreviated names of the states to which they belong to. Also frequent interstate transfer of members has also caused confusions regarding the registration numbers of the members. Therefore it was decided to merge the names of all the members regardless of the state to which they belong to and give a single registration number with the category of membership mentioned against their names, similar to the directory of USI. Categorisation of members has also been difficult, since many members left the zone, after completing their PG degree, never to return. As per the decisions of the Executive Council, the new consolidated Membership Directory has been prepared and circulated to all members for approval. The final directory is expected to be ready soon.

ASU Meetings

After the AGM held at Kochi on 9 August 2014, there has been three meetings of the Executive Council of the ASU. Healthy discussions took place during these meetings and the decisions were always unanimous. The office bearers always stood together whenever there was a problem to be solved. The next Council Meeting will be held on 10 July 2015 and the AGM will be held on 11 July 2015 at Vizag.

Obituary

The strength of ASU has been weakened by the sad demise of three able founder members, Prof.Ranganatha Rao, Dr.M.G.Desai and Prof. David Joseph. We remember with gratitude their earnest services and pray that their souls rest in peace.

Conclusions

With the revamping of activities and addition of new members, ASU will soon be the best professional association in India, if not internationally. The society remembers with gratitude the services and advices of all senior and junior members, which have contributed enormously for the growth of ASU. Let us stand united and be proud to be an ASU-an.

Prof. David Joseph



Prof. David Joseph, born on 31.5.1932,did his BSc. Zoology at the Madras Christian College, MBBS from CMC Vellore (1952 batch), post graduate surgical training in England and was awarded FRCS from Edinburgh. He joined the Medical College service on his return from England in the Dept. of Surgery. He took leave from Government service and joined for MCh Urology at CMC, Vellore under the legendary Prof.H.S.Bhat. He passed MCh

Urology in 1969 and joined back in Trivandrum Medical College. Prof. David Joseph became the founder Director of the Dept. of Urology at the same college. He was instrumental in starting the first MCh Urology program in Kerala. A man of varied interest, he was a wonderful singer of English classical music with a rich baritone anda member, Past President of Trivandrum Male VoiceChoristers association.With his passing away on 3.3.2015 we have lost not just a great teacher of Urology but also a wonderful voice with a rich repertoire. He is survived by his wife Mrs. Mary Joseph, sons Dr. Pradeep, Dr. Pramod and daughter Dr.Praveena.
