

19th Annual Conference of Karnataka Urology Association (KUACON 2014), Bangalore

The 19th Annual conference of the Karnataka Urology conference was held on 13th& 14th September 2014 at NIMHANS Convention centre, Bangalore. The conference was hosted by the Department of Urology, Institute of Nephro-Urology, Bangalore.



This conference was attended by a record number of 254 delegates which included 207 Urologists and 47 trade delegates. The conference was inaugurated by Dr. Sharanprakash Patil, Hon'ble Minister for Medical Education, Government of Karnataka. On 13th September 2014, scientific session started with Davangere Postgraduate symposium on Non muscle invasive Bladder cancer which was moderated by Dr R B Nerli. The prestigious Professor P Venugopal oration was delivered by Dr Rajesh Ahlawat who spoke on Robotic Renal transplantation-Journey so far. Dr. Pratap Kumar spoke on Choosing Infertile male for assisted reproductive techniques delivering the Dr M P Raju MYSOGUS Endowment lecture. There were six video abstracts for the NU Trust best video prize session. Dilip Adappa Best paper presentation had 10 abstracts which competed for the prize. 17 abstracts were presented for the Bangalore Medical college Best poster prize.

This conference had a scientific feast which covered various sub specialities in Urology in different formats. Session on Point of Technique- Tips & Tricks in which Dr S K Pal spoke on PCNL and Dr S V Kandasami spoke on TURP. Dr. Padmaraj

Hegde conducted the Bijapur Uro-Quiz. Annual General Body Meeting was held at 5pm. There was Gala Banquet at Hotel Chancery Pavilion which was entertaining and well appreciated.

OBITUARY Prof.Ranganatha Rao

He served as Assistant Professor of Surgery in Andhra Medical College, Vizag and Gandhi Medical College, Hyderabad from 1962-1970. He then served as Professor and Head of Dept. of Urology in Osmaina Medical College from 1970 to 1983, during which he started the renal transplant program and post graduate education program. He also worked as honorary consultant in Urology at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad. He was an examiner to many MCh (Urology) candidates all across the country. He also served as Honorary Secretary of USI (1982-86) and President of USI (1989). He was very soft spoken and has always been an inspiring force for the young Urologists in the state of Andhra Pradesh. He is a proud founder member of Association of Southern Urologists. We regret you to inform you the unkindly demise of one of our members Dr. Mallikarjuna Gurappa Desai from Bengaluru on 28th January 2015. He was an alumnus from PGI Chandigarh and was working as Professor of Urology at Ambedkar Medical College. He was an active member of the society. The Society expresses deep sorrow for this loss, and may his soul rest in peace.

"Beware of Compliments"

This is the true story of an incidence wherein a company named Endosys, Chennai, took the organizers of SZUSICON 2014 for a ride. Mr.K.V Santharam, M/s Endosys Technologies, 572, Kaveri Complex, 96, M.G Road, Nungambakkam, Chennai 600 034 (Phone: 09384560061) approached the organizers of SZUSICON 2014 on 30.7.14 and confirmed their trade participation during the Conference at a special discounted stall rate of Rs.60,000 for three days. Accordingly they were allotted stall no.9 in Area 2 of Trade Zone during the conference. As per the rules of conference, the entire payment should have been made before the start of the conference. However the company never made a payment in spite of repeated requests from organizers.

A representative from the above company came to occupy the stall on 8th August 2014, Friday (1st day of conference). However he was prevented from doing so, by the organizers due to default in payment. The gentleman left the scene to came back on 9th



August 2014 (Saturday) and begged that he may be permitted to occupy the stall, since he vouched that the payment had already been made by his company via RTGS transfer. A confirmation email was soon received by the organizers from M/s Endosys (copy attached), which was reconfirmed by telephonic conversation with Mr. Santharam who was in Chennai. However being a Saturday and the bank where the conference account was operated worked only till 12.00 noon, verification at the bank was not possible at that instance. The company duly occupied the stall by the noon of 9th August 2014. On 10th August 2014, once the conference was over the representative of M/s Endosys brought in 2 endoscope sterilization boxes to the organizers and presented to them as "compliment", which he said was customary for the company over the last several years whenever they participate in trade exhibition, as a token of gratitude. The organizers seriously objected to this; however the representative pleaded that this be accepted since he felt that this was the first occasion when a gift offered by him was rejected by the receiver. The organizers accepted and kept the two "compliments" in the office itself.

On verification of accounts in the bank on 11th August 2014, it was understood that there was never an RTGS transfer made by the said company to the conference account and the e-mail was forged.

This was brought to the notice of Mr. Santharam, who was then repeatedly contacted by the organizers—but there was no reply or action from the offenders. The organizing Secretary of SZUSICON

20014, Dr.Krishna Moorthy along with the Hony.Treasurer of ASU made a valiant attempt to barge into the premises of the said office of M/s Endosys at Chennai on 13th September 2014. Mr. Santharam was shocked to see the team, whom he had cheated. After repeated requests and threats from the organizers, Mr. Santharam agreed to settle the issue in 48 hrs time.

However 2 days later the organizers received a mail from M/s Endosys informing that the organizers had "purchased" two endoscope boxes from them during the conferences and the dues of Rs.60,000 may be adjusted against the payment to be made by the company towards the conference

It is disheartening to believe that companies of this nature do cheat the entire doctor community at times for their own personal benefits. We are just game to the cruel deeds of them. The "compliments" given by them might get charged later!! Legal experts believe that it would never be possible to recover the money from these defaulters, since it is virtually impossible for any organizers to get all agreements written on stamp paper, signed by witness and notarized; this being the only valuable document accepted by courts as evidence in these cases. We have to be wiser next time when dealing with people like Mr. Santharam's M/s Endosys.
